

ADMISSION NOTICE

(in respect of admissions for the 2025/2026 school year)

The Board of Management of Dunboyne Junior Primary School has prepared this Admission Notice with respect to the admission of students to the school for the school year 20254/26. It is subject to the terms of our Admissions Policy and the Education (Admission to Schools) Act 2018.

Our Admissions Policy is published on the school website (www.dunboynejps.ie) or can be obtained on request by emailing office@dunboynejps.ie or in hard copy from the school office.

The following are the details applicable for admission to Junior Infants only.

Applications for admission to Junior Infants for the school year 2025/2026 will be accepted from:	1st October 2024.
The school shall cease accepting applications for Junior Infant admission to the school for 2025/2026 on:	31st October 2024 at 12 p.m.
The latest date by which applicants will be notified of the decision on their application is:	15th November 2024.
Applicants must confirm acceptance of an offer of admission: Failure to accept an offer within the prescribed period above may result in the offer being withdrawn:	within 7 days of the date of the offer of a place.

Applications made after the 31st of October 2024 will be processed as late applications; the school will consider and issue decisions on late applications in accordance with the school's Admission Policy.

Number of places: there will be a total of 120 places available (5 classes with a maximum of 24 students in each class). Where the number of applications received exceeds the number of places available, these applications will be processed under the terms of our Admissions Policy.
